Tue, Jan 23 UNITED STATES TO DUBLIN

Enjoy an overnight flight across the Atlantic to Dublin.

Wed, Jan 24 DUBLIN ARRIVAL, LIMERICK & KING JOHNS CASTLE

After landing at Dublin Airport, you will meet your driver/guide who will welcome you to Ireland. Departing the airport, stop at a local restaurant, for a traditional Irish breakfast. Drive southwest to the city of Limerick on the banks of the Shannon River. Visit King Johns Castle which guards the mouth of the river. This mighty fortress has protected this inland passage for centuries. After your tour, walk along the banks of the Shannon, past the Treaty Stone, on your way to your first hotel. Perhaps you may want to stop along the way for a pint or two. Check into your hotel overlooking the city and relax before joining your fellow travelers for dinner. This evening you can explore Limerick's lively pub scene.

Hotel & Dinner: The Strand Hotel, Limerick

Thu, Jan 25 BUNRATTY CASTLE, CLIFFS OF MOHER & THE BURREN

This morning drive a short distance into County Clare to the village of Bunratty. Enjoy a visit to Bunratty Castle & Folk Park set on the grounds of a Viking settlement from the 10th century. Climb to the battlements of the 15th century tower house and walk through the folk park to see examples of Irish home and town life through the centuries. Perhaps you may even stop for a pint in Mac's Pub or Durty Nelly's Pub before driving to the coast to see the Cliffs of Moher. Towering above the Atlantic, these cliffs offer breathtaking views. Continue into the moonlike region of the Burren. Stop to visit the Poulnabrone Dolmen. This passage tomb predates the Egyptian Pyramids and Stonehenge. Drive to the university city of Galway and check into your hotel situated in the center of town. Enjoy dinner with your group before hitting some of Galway's many pubs.

Hotel & Dinner: The Hardiman Hotel, Galway

Fri, Jan 26 GALWAY WALKING TOUR, CONNEMARA & KYLEMORE ABBEY

This morning enjoy a walking tour of Galway, "The City of Tribes". Visit Galway Cathedral and St. Nicholas Church, where Columbus prayed before journeying to the New World. See the Spanish Arch, Lynch's Castle, and Eyre Square before heading out into Connemara. Travel past mountains, boglands and villages. Stop at Kylemore Abbey set on a lough with a mountainous backdrop. Once a stately home, then a girl's school, this is now associated with Notre Dame University. On your journey back to Galway stop along Galway Bay for an early pub dinner at Pdracin's Bar and Restaurant. Enjoy dinner as you see the sun go down on Galway Bay. Return to Galway and enjoy a night out on the town.

Hotel: The Hardiman Hotel, Galway

Sat, Jan 27 DUBLIN CITY TOUR & GUINNESS STOREHOUSE

This morning drive across the center of the country through the midlands along the ancient trade route. Upon arrival into Dublin, take a sightseeing tour of Ireland's capital city. Drive past the ancient buildings, churches and monuments learning about the history of the city. Visit the Guinness Storehouse and learn how this world-renowned beer is brewed. Enjoy a pint of your own at the rooftop bar. The rest of the day and evening is free to explore Dublin's sights, restaurants, and pubs.
