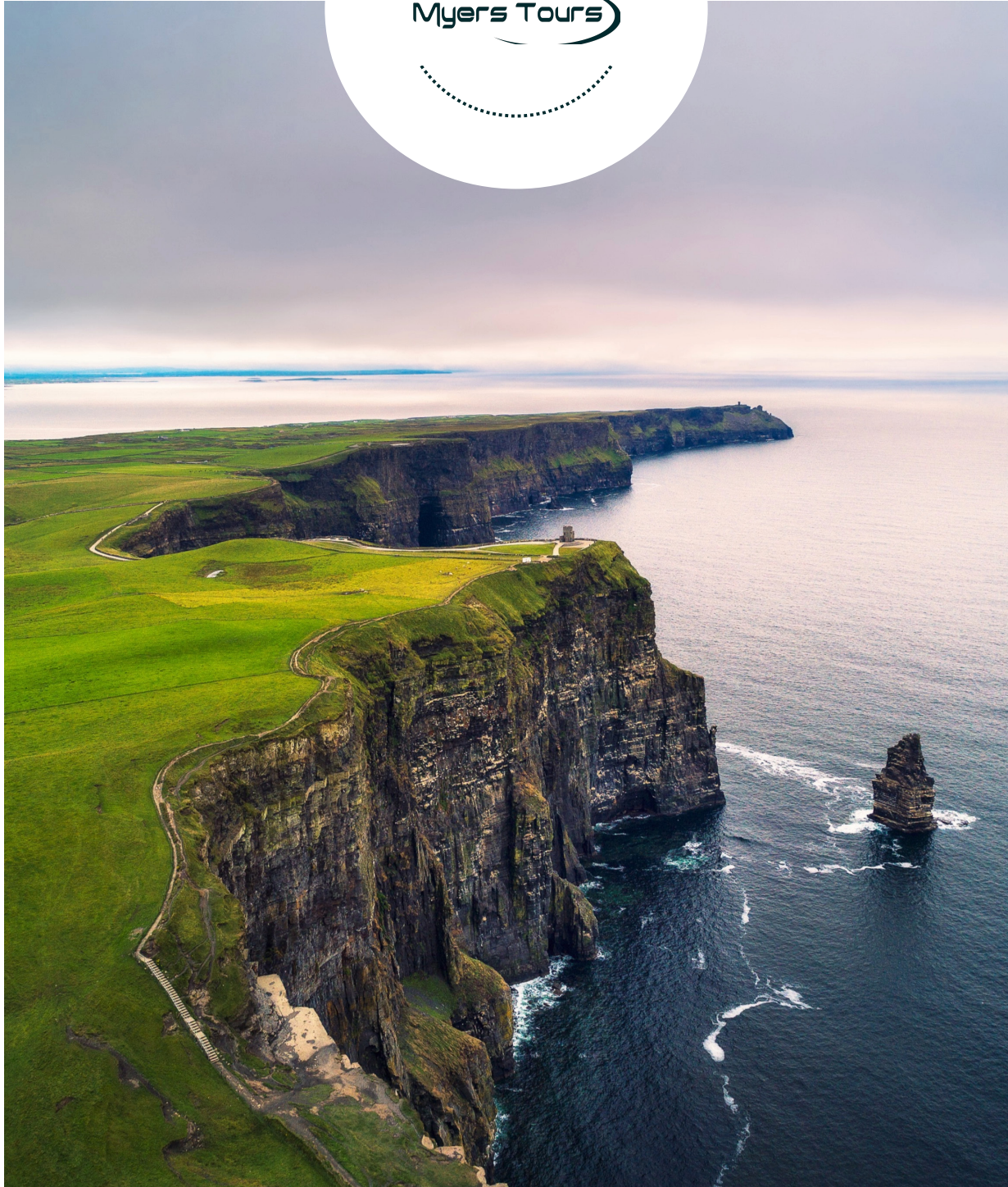

Tour Overview



Arrive in Dublin

Arrive at Dublin Airport, where the excitement starts. After breakfast at a local restaurant, we'll journey west to explore **Clonmacnoise**, a fascinating monastic site filled with ancient ruins and Celtic crosses. Then it's on to **Athlone** for a stop at **Sean's Bar** — Ireland's oldest pub — for a taste of history and maybe a pint or two. Upon reaching **Galway**, enjoy a **guided walking tour** through its colorful streets before an afternoon of leisure to wander, shop, or relax by the harbor. The day ends with a warm welcome dinner at our hotel, kicking off an unforgettable Irish adventure.



Galway

After breakfast at the hotel, we set out for a scenic drive through the rugged beauty of **Connemara**, where mountains meet the sea. From Rossaveal, we board the **ferry to Aranmore**, one of the enchanting **Aran Islands**. There, we'll tour the island's highlights, including the ancient stone **fort of Dún Aonghasa** perched dramatically on the cliffs. After soaking in the breathtaking views and island charm, we return by ferry to the mainland and make our way back to Galway. **The evening is yours to enjoy** — explore the lively pubs, listen to traditional music, or simply relax and take in the magic of this coastal city.



Killarney

After breakfast, we begin our journey south through the striking limestone landscape of **The Burren**, stopping to see the ancient **Poulnabrone Dolmen** — one of Ireland's most iconic portal tombs. Continuing along the Wild Atlantic Way, we take in the beauty of the **Cliffs of Moher**, where sweeping ocean views and dramatic cliffs steal the show. We'll pause in the charming village of **Kilmurry McMahon** in County Clare before crossing **the River Shannon** on the **Tarbert Ferry**. Our day concludes with a warm welcome and dinner at our hotel in Killarney.

Dingle

After breakfast, we set out for a breathtaking drive along the **Dingle Peninsula**, one of Ireland's most scenic routes filled with rugged coastline, rolling hills, and charming villages. Along the way, we'll enjoy a fascinating **sheepdog demonstration**, showcasing the incredible skill and teamwork between shepherd and dog. In **Dingle**, you'll have **free time** to explore the colorful harbor town, browse local shops, or grab lunch at a seaside café. We then **return to Killarney for a relaxing evening** at leisure — perfect for strolling the town, enjoying live music in a local pub.



Ring of Kerry

Embark on a spectacular day exploring some of Ireland's most iconic scenery. We'll take in the serene beauty of the **Lakes of Killarney** and the dramatic mountain pass of the **Gap of Dunloe**, with a stop at Moriarty's for a bit of shopping and local charm. The journey continues along the famous **Ring of Kerry**, where every turn reveals stunning coastal views, charming villages, and postcard-perfect landscapes. We return to Killarney for our final evening — a chance to savor the town's warm hospitality, enjoy a farewell pint, and reflect on the unforgettable memories made throughout our Irish adventure.



Blarney Castle

Let's travel east toward Blarney to visit the famous **Blarney Castle**, where you can kiss the legendary stone said to bring the gift of eloquence. Continuing on, we enjoy a panoramic tour of **Cork City**, followed by time in the charming seaside town of **Cobh** — the last port of call for the Titanic — to explore its colorful streets and rich maritime history. Glendalough

Dublin City
